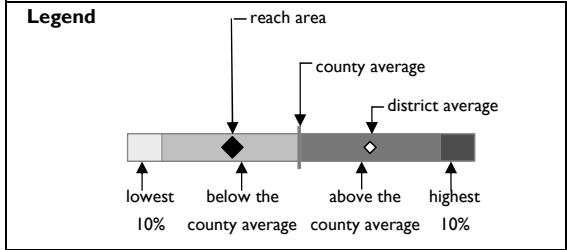

Melton

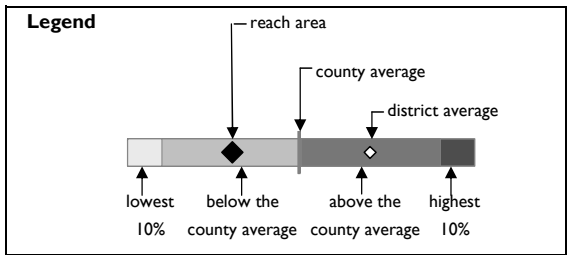
Description

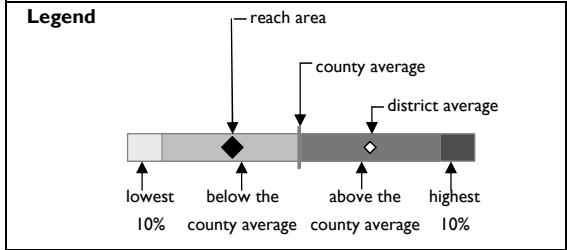
