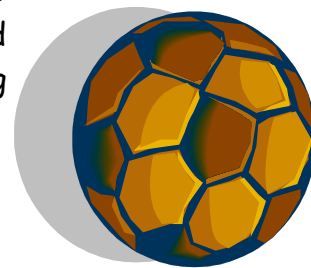

CHAT CLINIC

The C.H.A.T Clinic is a Confidential Health Advice Clinic for teenagers. The clinic is held at Latham House and at The COVE. There is no need to book an appointment, and whether you are sixteen or under you can visit without your parent or carer. The clinic is there to listen and advise. No one will pass on any information about your visit unless they think you or someone else is in serious danger.

What can they offer: health advice, confidential chats, information about your health and information relating to sexual health. They can offer assistance in stopping smoking, discuss eating and weight issues, offer advice on alcohol and drug misuse and offer advice on STI's and contraception. You can have someone you trust with you and ask to see a male or female health worker if you wish.

They work with other agencies who give help and support to young people. If they can't offer what you need, they will put you in touch with the relevant people.
