RAGE are pleased to announce that Melton Borough Council have allocated two garages on the ward for residents to deposit their bulky waste items. These items will then be collected for removal by Verdant. RAGE will also be accepting any unwanted white goods, which will be disposed of free of charge.

We must emphasise that this is not for general household waste or black bags - Bulky items and white goods only. The garages are on Rockingham Drive and will be manned by members of the RAGE committee.

The first open garage will be on December 4th, 1-3pm. Due to Christmas the second open garage will be January 8th 1-3pm. If this proves successful we are hoping to run one open garage each month. Please do not leave items at the garages at any other times!

BINGO

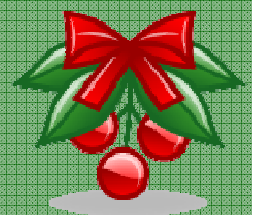
